WHAT IS DIGNITY OF RISK?



You can choose to take some risk to enjoy your life



For example, you might like to eat sweets everyday even though it is not healthy



We want to respect your decision, and work with you to manage your risk



This means we might suggest that you eat sweets every Sunday, rather than everyday

WHAT IS DUTY OF CARE?



Your support staff want to help you in your everyday life



They have a **duty** to keep you safe and to understand what may happen if you make a risky decision



Duty means that it is their job to do something



You can talk to them before making a risky decision

HOW INTERACTION CAN HELP YOU



We want you to live your life the way you want to



We will do our best to support you, and keep you safe



You can talk with staff before you make any risky decisions



Staff are here to help you. Ask them for advice or help when needed
